# Call for the allocation of free accommodation benefits for the academic year 2020/21

Collegio Universitario di Torino Renato Einaudi offers for the most deserving students 4 free accommodation benefits, divided as following:

- **2** accommodations for the students enrolled to a course of study of the “**Politecnico**” group
- **1** accommodation for the students enrolled to a **scientific course of study of the “Università” group**
- **1** accommodation for the students enrolled to a **humanistic course of study of the “Università” group**

## *Requirements*

To be considered eligible for the free accommodation, student must meet the following requirements:

- having been the **owner of an accommodation benefit for the a.y. 2020/2021**;
- having used the hospitality service offered by Collegio **for a minimum of 5 months during the a.y. 2020/2021** (the total includes the eventual lockdown weeks that the student might have spent outside the Collegio).

The following categories of students are **excluded** from subscribing to this call:

- students that enrolled to a bachelor degree before the a.y. 2018/2019;
- students that enrolled to a single cycle degree program or a master’s degree before the a.y. 2016/2017 (except for those attending Medicine and Dentistry);
- students that enrolled to a single cycle degree program in the sanitary field (Medicine and Dentistry) before the a.y. 2015/2016;
- students that enrolled to a master’s degree before the a.y. 2019/2020;
- owners of an accommodation thanks to the agreements signed between the Collegio and external Institutions, on the condition that the annual fee is completely paid for by the said Institution (Collegio Carlo Alberto, Scuola di Studi Superiori dell’Università degli Studi di Torino “Ferdinando Rossi”, INPS ex Enam, etc.);

- students enrolled to a PhD or post-degree specializing course (3rd level);
- winners of a paid accommodation benefit for the a.y. 2020/2021 thanks to other bans.

## Rankings

For each group (“Politecnico” or “Università”) the ranking of all the applications will be compiled following these criteria, to be applied in this order in cases of tie:

**1**

**score that consists of the weighted average of the marks concerning the credits acquired during the academic year 2020/2021** (from the 1st of September 2020 to the 31st of July 2021), multiplied by a corrective factor that consists of the minor between 1 and the ratio between the number of credits acquired in the specific academic year and the following constant set by the Collegio:

- 52 credits for the freshmen that enrolled to a bachelor degree or single cycle degree program in the a.y. 2020/2021;
- 56 credits for students enrolled to the second or above year of a bachelor degree, or single cycle degree program, or master’s degree in the a.y. 2020/2021.

**The credits of the exams that do not entail any final evaluation** (including the final thesis) won’t be considered during the weighted average but will be included in the compute of the corrective factor.

**The language exams that do not entail any final evaluation and the eventual extra exams related to projects such as the Giovani Talenti program of the Politecnico**, will not be considered neither in the weighted average nor in the corrective factor.

**The “lode” will not be taken into consideration for the weighted average.**

The values of the weighted average, of the corrective factor and of the general score will be rounded up to the third decimal<sup>1</sup>

**The free accommodation benefits will not be assigned to the students that have a score below 20 points.**

The rankings will be published in the ESITI GRADUATORIE (“RANKINGS”) area of the Portale Studenti before the 22nd of October, 2021.

<sup>1</sup> The rounding will be done by:

- rounding down the third decimal if the fourth is comprised between 0 and 4;
- rounding up the third decimal if the fourth is comprised between 5 and 9;

# Call for the allocation of free accommodation benefits

## *Methods of participation*

To apply to this call it is necessary to:

- fill the form on the Portale Studenti **from the 12th to the 31st of July, 2021**
- **upload the self-declaration of the exams done up to July 31st** in the CARICA DOCUMENTI PG (“UPLOAD DOCUMENTS PG”) area of the Portale Studenti.

**NOTE:** since this call concerns the academic year 2020/2021, it will be necessary to select the correct year in the home page of the Portale Studenti (after the login the Portale Studenti will automatically show the results for the a.y. 2021/2022)

## *Benefits allocation*

The annual fee of the a.y. 2020/2021 will be refunded to the winners of this call by bank transfer **no later than January 2022.**

Eventual ulterior free accommodations will be assigned to the students following the rankings, within the will of the institutors.

The free accommodation is not compatible with any type of extra payment in the form of scholarships or agreement with external institutions, with the only exception of provisions for international mobility projects. The winners of this call will subscribe to the proper declaration during the participation process online.

The winners of the free accommodation will not be eligible for any study award offered by the Collegio for the same academic year.

The list of the winners will be shared with the Università degli Studi di Torino, the Politecnico di Torino and the “Ente Regionale per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario del Piemonte”.
