Collegio Universitario di Torino Renato Einaudi announces, for the year 2021,

42 Study Awards (for a total amount of € 39,500)

reserved for students who hold study places in Collegio for the academic year 2020/21,
financed through donations and contributions received from private subjects
during the academic year 2020/21.

Requirements for the assignment of a Study Award:



having been **holder of a study place in the academic year 2020/21 for at least 5 months** (including in the calculation of the 5 months also the weeks of lockdown that may not have been spent in Collegio);



in the case of **students involved in international mobility study projects, having used the hospitality service of the Collegio for at least 5 months during the academic year 2020/21;**



apply in the period between **10/18/2021 and 11/5/2021.**

They will not be able to participate in this announcement:

- students of 1st level courses who enrolled in ay prior to 2018/19;
- students of single-cycle degree courses (except Medicine and Dentistry) who enrolled in ay prior to 2016/17;
- students of single-cycle degree courses in the health area (Medicine and Dentistry) who enrolled in ay prior to 2015/16;
- students of master's degree courses enrolled in ay prior to 2019/20;
- the students holding a study place following agreements stipulated by the Collegio, whose tuition for the academic year 2020/21 is fully paid by the affiliated institution (eg: Carlo Alberto College, School of Higher Studies, INPS ex Enam, etc.);
- students with study positions enrolled in research doctorates, 2nd level masters, specialization schools, advanced courses.



Participants in this announcement are invited to **evaluate the compatibility of the Study Prizes up for grabs with other provisions of public and private bodies**. In this regard, it should be noted that EDISU Piemonte has confirmed the compatibility of this announcement with its scholarship.

Methods for submitting the application and formulating the rankings

For each group, the ranking of all the applications presented will be formulated on the basis of the score obtained by each candidate, calculated as follows:

Academic performance: with the attribution of a score deriving from the weighted average of the marks on the credits acquired in the academic year 2020/21 (exams taken from 1 September 2020 to 31 July 2021), multiplied by a corrective factor, equal to the lower of “1” And the ratio between the number of credits acquired in the academic year of reference and the value set by Collegio as follows:

- **52 credits** for students enrolled in **bachelor's (three-year) or single-cycle degree courses** in the academic year 2020/21;
- **56 credits** for students enrolled, in the academic year 2020/21, **for years subsequent** to the first one in bachelor's or single-cycle degree courses and for students enrolled in courses of master's degree.



Credits acquired in exams that do not involve grades, and for which only passing is recognized (including the thesis), will not contribute to the calculation of the weighted average of the marks, but will be considered in the calculation of the corrective factor.

The linguistic knowledge exams for which only passing is recognized and any extra exams (for example those taken as part of the Young Talents / Enterprising project of the Politecnico) will not contribute to forming either the weighted average or the corrective factor.

Honors will not be evaluated for the purpose of calculating the weighted average. The weighted average, correction factor and score values will be rounded to the third decimal number².

In the event of a tie resulting from the two criteria described above, the ranking will be drawn up according to the following criteria, to be applied in succession in the event of a tie:

- greater number of praises;
- indicator of the equivalent economic situation of the lowest household.

The study prizes will not be awarded to students who will result in the ranking with a score lower than 20.

To submit an application under this Call, it is necessary to:

1. fill in the participation form at the link <https://forms.gle/6SUWNcGq8s8PDJtv9> in the period from **18 October to 5 November 2021**;
2. only **for candidates participating in the Call for Confirmation** for the academic year 2021/22, if necessary, update the self-certification of the exams taken as at 31/7/2021 in the OTHER DOCUMENTS area of the Student Portal;
3. only **for candidates who did not participate in the Confirmation Announcement** for the academic year 2021/22, register on the Student Portal and upload the self-certification of the exams taken on 31/7/2021 in the OTHER DOCUMENTS area of the Student Portal.

Any prizes that cannot be assigned to a group due to lack of suitable candidates will be distributed to the other groups as follows:

- in the event of exhaustion of one of the two University groupings, the relative non-assignable study prizes will be allocated to the other University grouping;
- in case of exhaustion of both University groups, the non-assignable study prizes will be

² The rounding will be carried out:

- approximating the third decimal down, if the fourth decimal is between 0 and 4,
- approximating the third decimal up, if the fourth decimal is between 5 and 9.

allocated to the Politecnico group.

- in case of exhaustion of the Politecnico grouping, the non-assignable study prizes will be allocated to the University grouping with the highest number of students still in the ranking.

The study prizes reserved for students belonging to particular degree courses may be assigned to students of the same group, but enrolled in different Degree Programs only upon specific request of the donor.

If it is not possible to assign all the Study Awards announced due to a lack of suitable candidates, any remaining funds will be used to finance the institutional activities of the Foundation for the year 2021.

Any further Study Prizes that may become available for this Call may be awarded no later than the day of publication of the rankings.

In the event that a candidate turns out to be a winner / winner of Study Prizes in several rankings, he / she will benefit only and exclusively from the Prize with the highest amount.

The student who has been assigned a free study place will not be able to obtain the assignment of a study award granted by the Collegio for the same academic year.

The winners of the Study Prizes covered by this Announcement will be asked to upload in the OTHER DOCUMENTS area of the Student Portal of:

- a presentation form of their academic career;
- a half-length photograph and one in the context of study / internship;
- the authorization to use the material requested for the institutional purposes of Collegio.

In order to proceed with the awarding of the prize, the winners will be asked to fill in the IBAN area of the Student Portal, carefully checking the bank details provided.

The rankings will be published in the Collegio's intranet area by 3 December 2021 and the Prizes will be paid, by bank transfer, by February 2022.

The official award ceremony of the winners, in the presence of donors and donors, will be held in a public ceremony in December 2021, compatibly with the progress of the epidemiological emergency from COVID-19.
