In memory of the colleague Silvia Casale, who passed away prematurely, Collegio is establishing a GOLD award as a tangible commitment to continue — also through this award — to nurture the dedication and passion that Silvia always demonstrated in her work at the Foundation and for the good cause of the Collegio.

Call for Study Awards

The Study Awards will be awarded on the basis of merit rankings and will have different amounts, as follows:

Gold Award	Silver Award	Bronze Award

It should be noted that the funds, bound by donors, are reserved for the following Degree Courses:

- Chemistry and/or Chemical Engineering
- Mechanical and/or Aerospace engineering
- ICT area
- Medicine and related disciplines
- MFN Sciences
- Humanistic area
- Engineering Area
- Physics and/or physical engineering
- Architecture and/or civil/construction engineering

Any additional funds, not tied to specific study paths, will be assigned:

- between the PoliTO, UniTO Humanistic, UniTO Scientific groupings in a proportion equal to the distribution of the Collegio population among the same groups;
- as a percentage of types of amount such as to favor the SILVER and, above all, BRONZE denomination.

Requirements for the assignment of a Study Award

The following requirements must be met:

-  Having been holder of a study place in the academic year 2024/25 for at least 5 months;
-  In the case of students involved in international mobility study projects, having used the hospitality service of the Collegio for at least 5 months during the academic year 2024/25;
-  Apply in the period **between 10/12/2025 and 11/01/2026**.

Call for Study Awards

They will not be able to participate in this Call:

- students of 1st level courses who enrolled in a.y. prior to 2022/23;
- students of single-cycle degree courses (except Medicine and Dentistry) who enrolled in a.y. prior to 2020/21;
- students of single-cycle degree courses in the health area (Medicine and Dentistry) who enrolled in a.y. prior to 2019/20;
- students of master's degree courses enrolled in a.y. prior to 2023/24;
- students holding a study place following agreements stipulated by the Collegio, whose tuition for the academic year 2024/25 is fully or partially paid by the affiliated institution (eg: Collegio Carlo Alberto, Scuola di Studi Superiori di Torino, INPS, etc.);
- students holding a study place who were awarded a grant for a free study place in the academic year 2024/25, in accordance with the respective announcements published in June and September 2024;
- students with study positions enrolled in research doctorates, 2nd level masters, specialization schools, advanced courses.

! Participants in this Call are invited to evaluate the compatibility of the Study Awards up for grabs with other provisions of public and private bodies. In this regard, it should be noted that EDISU Piemonte has confirmed the compatibility of this announcement with its scholarship.

Methods for submitting the application and formulating the rankings

For each group, the ranking of all the applications presented will be formulated on the basis of the score, expressed out of thirty, obtained by each candidate, calculated according to the following criteria:

- 1. Academic performance:** with the attribution of a score deriving from the weighted average of the marks on the credits acquired in the academic year 2024/25 (exams taken from 1 September 2024 to 31 July 2025), including – for students simultaneously enrolled in two degree programs (see L. 33/2022 and Ministerial Decrees no. 930 and no. 933 of July 29, 2022) – all credits related to the so-called “secondary” degree program. The average thus obtained will then be multiplied by a corrective factor equal to the lower of “1” “And the ratio between the number of credits acquired in the academic year of reference and the value set by Collegio as follows:
 - a. 52 credits for students enrolled in bachelor's (three-year) or single-cycle degree courses in the academic year 2024/25;
 - b. 56 credits for students enrolled, in the academic year 2024/25, for years subsequent to the first one in bachelor's or single-cycle degree courses and for students enrolled in courses of master's degree.

Credits acquired in exams that do not involve grades, and for which only passing is recognized (including the thesis), **will not contribute to the calculation of the weighted average of the marks**, but will be considered in the calculation of the corrective factor. Any extra exams (for example those taken as part of the progetto Intraprendenti of the Politecnico) will not contribute to forming either the weighted average or the corrective factor.

Honors will not be evaluated for the purpose of calculating the weighted average. The weighted average, correction factor and score values will be rounded to the third decimal number¹.

¹ Rounding will be done by rounding down the third decimal place if the fourth decimal place is between 0 and 4, or rounding up if the fourth decimal place is between 5 and 9.

2. **In the attribution of the final score**, the following factors will also be taken into account, where applicable or verifiable:

- **«Responsibility factor» or «malus»:** any fines incurred during the 2024/25 academic year, pursuant to Article XXII of the current Regulations for holders of study places, will result in a reduction of the final score by -0.14 points out of 30 for each fine, applied linearly;
- **«Engagement factor» or «bonus»:** positive participation during the 2024/25 academic year in **1) Community On projects** and/or **2) actions of improvement and collaboration within the Collegio community**, realized by being actively involved — as Section Delegates or otherwise — in working groups with the Staff including the Community Manager, will result in an increase of +0.14 points out of 30 in the final score. If a student is involved in more than one Community On project or other positive action, a progressively decreasing engagement factor will be applied: +0.14 for the first bonus, +0.07 for the second, and +0.04 for the third.

In the event of a tie based on the criteria described above, the ranking will be determined according to the following parameters, to be applied in succession:

- **greater number of honors;**
- **indicator of the equivalent economic situation of the lowest household.**

The Study Awards will not be awarded to students who will result in the ranking with a score lower than 20/30.
If a student has already won an award in 2024 from the Call for Study Awards for the academic year 2023/24, it will be placed at the end of the reference ranking.

To submit an application under this Call, it is required, during the period **from December 10, 2025, to January 11, 2026:**

2 update, if necessary, the **self-certification of the exams taken as at 31/7/2025** in the **OTHER DOCUMENTS** area of the Student Portal.

After the publication of the provisional rankings, for the assignment of awards specifically titled, the temporary winners may be involved in moments of in-depth study and knowledge of their history through an interview and/or production of a written paper, following of which the final rankings will be published.

If it is not possible to use all the Study Awards announced due to a lack of candidates, any funds used for the institutional activities of the Foundation. Further study awards may also be awarded if they became available for this Call, thanks to donations received by the day of publication of the final rankings.

The student who has been assigned a free study place will not be able to obtain the assignment of a study award granted by the Collegio for the same academic year.

The provisional rankings will be published in the Collegio's website by February, 3 2026. These rankings will become definitive after 3 calendar days.

Call for Study Awards

The winners of the Study Awards awarded under this Call will be required to submit, **via a ticket on the Student Portal** (category and subject: “Study awards”), **by February 15, 2026**:

- a **presentation form** of their academic career;
- a **half-length photograph and one in the context of study/internship**;
- the **authorization to use the material requested** for the institutional purposes of Collegio;
- **fill in the IBAN area of the Student Portal**, carefully checking the bank details provided.

The awards will be paid in a single payment, via wire transfer, by the end of March 2026, on a bank account in the name or jointly held by the winner. Any additional costs relating to payment operations (eg: foreign wire transfer) will be borne by the winner.
