YEAR 2021

Collegio Universitario di Torino Renato Einaudi announces for the year 2021 **three career awards of € 1,000** gross each in memory of the engineer Ermanno Borio, established thanks to the generous testamentary legacy of Mrs. Clara Borio, sister of Ermanno, former student of Collegio from 1949 to 1954.

The prizes are divided as follows:

NO. 2 PRIZES RESERVED TO GRADUATES OF FIRST LEVEL DEGREE COURSES BE-LONGING TO THE FOLLOWING DEGREE CLASSES (Grouping former I faculty):

- Aerospace Engineering;
- Biomedical Engineering;
- Chemical and food engineering;
- Civil Engineering;
- Construction Engineering;
- Electrical engineering;
- Energetic engineering;
- Mechanical engineering;
- Engineering for the environment and the territory;
- Mathematics for engineering;
- Territorial, urban and landscape-environmental planning ;
- Materials engineering;
- Industrial production engineering.

NO. 1 PRIZE RESERVED FOR GRADUATES OF FIRST LEVEL DEGREE COURSES BE-LONGING TO THE FOLLOWING DEGREE CLASSES (Grouping ex III and IV faculties):

- Motor vehicle engineering;
- Telecommunications engineering;
- Electronic Engineering;
- Management engineering;
- Computer engineering;
- Cinema and Media Engineering;
- Physical engineering;
- Technologies for the manufacturing industry.

Recipients

The recipients of the award are the students of Collegio who:

1. have been holders of a study place in Collegio in the **academic year 2020/2021¹**;
2. have been enrolled in the academic year 2020/21 at the Politecnico di Torino in a first level degree course among those indicated in the groupings indicated above;
3. have enrolled in the first level degree course in the **academic year 2018/19**;
4. have obtained, or are about to obtain, a first level degree **by 31 December 2021 with a degree grade equal to or greater than 100/110**.

They will not be able to participate in this announcement:

- the students holding a study place following agreements stipulated by Collegio, whose tuition for the academic year 2020/21 is fully paid by the affiliated institution (eg: Carlo Alberto College, School of Higher Studies, INPS ex Enam, etc.);
- the students who have won a free study place or a GOLD study award for the academic year 2020/21.

How to participate

Candidates must **by and no later than 31 December 2021**:

- fill in the online form available at the link <https://forms.gle/a9ugKJPHD2BzV3ESA>;
- send via ticket on the Student Portal (object: "Premi Borio alla carriera 2021"):
 - self-certification of all exams taken in the entire bachelor's degree program, showing the academic year of enrollment, the weighted average, the total number of credits, the achievement of the bachelor's degree and the grade obtained ;
 - motivation letter drawn up by the candidate;
 - any letters of reference from the teacher supervisor / thesis supervisor and / or the teacher of the foreign university and / or the company tutor.

Only applications for which the candidates have submitted all the required documentation according to the methods mentioned above will be considered valid.

¹ Students who, during the academic year 2020/21 have been involved in international / national mobility projects (e.g. Erasmus mobility projects) and have maintained the ownership of the place of study in Collegio for at least 5 months in the academic year. 2020/21

Methods of constructing the rankings

A ranking will be drawn up for each grouping based on the sum of the scores listed be-low:

- up to a maximum of 110 points corresponding to the bachelor's degree mark³;
- up to a maximum of 30 points corresponding to the weighted average of the ex-ams taken in the entire first level degree course;
- up to a maximum of 20 points awarded by a Scientific Commission designated by the Board of Directors of Collegio, which will evaluate:
 - to) The time taken to finish your studies;
 - b) Evaluation of the course of study carried out partially or entirely in Eng-lish;
 - c) A series of information on the student's degree path (for example, number of laude obtained, foreign path, any extracurricular activities, etc.).

The Commission's judgment will be final.

The final rankings will be published in the Collegio's INTRANET **by 31 January 2022**.

The communication of the publication will be given through the social channels and the website of the Collegio.

Methods of disbursement of prizes

The prizes will be paid out in a single payment, **by the end of February 2022**, by bank transfer to a current account in the name or joint name of the winner / winner.

Any additional costs relating to payment operations (eg: foreign bank transfer) will be borne by the winner / winner.

Following the publication of the rankings, the winners must communicate their bank de-tails by filling in or updating the IBAN area of the Student Portal.
