Call for study Abroad Program

The Collegio Universitario di Torino Renato Einaudi announces a Call for the academic year 2024/25 for the allocation of financial contributions aimed at attending a **language course abroad**, financed through Collegio funds and a testamentary bequest in memory of Ermanno Borio.

Subject of the call

The call provides **33 financial contributions**, divided as follows:

- **Sezione CROCETTA:** 8 contributions
- **Sezione SAN PAOLO:** 7 contributions
- **Sezione PO:** 6 contributions
- **Sezione VALENTINO:** 6 contributions
- **Sezione MOLE ANTONELLIANA:** 6 contributions

The financial contribution consists of a reimbursement of expenses up to a maximum of **€ 1.100,00**.

Reimbursable expenses, duly documented, include:

- **Round-trip travel expenses to the study abroad destination;**
- **Accommodation costs for the duration of the language course;**
- **Tuition fees for the language course.**

Excluded expenses:

- **Transport and/or accommodation costs incurred for stays in cities other than the departure and/or destination city.**
- **Meal expenses.**

However, public transportation expenses (tickets/subscriptions) within the city where the language course is held are included.

Study abroad requirements

The participant is solely responsible for organizing their stay.

The travel start date must not be before the publication date of the final rankings and must not be later than **August 15, 2025**.

The language course must last at least **two weeks** and must be in one of the official languages spoken in the chosen country.

The course must consist of at least **30 hours** in total.

Eligibility

The call is open to students of the **Collegio Universitario Einaudi** who hold a study place for the **A.Y. 2024/25** and meet the following criteria:

- Must have held a study place at the Collegio **since at least A.Y. 2023/24**;
- Must hold a study place for **A.Y. 2024/25**, even if engaged in international mobility projects during the current academic year, and must be present at the Collegio for at least **5 months**;
- Must be up to date with the payment of the third installment of their contribution (except for students exempt due to participation in international mobility projects during the second semester of A.Y. 2024/25);
- Must not have been awarded the **Ghita & Armando** scholarship or the **‘Oro’ study awards** for A.Y. 2023/24;
- Must have signed their **Personalized Learning Project** for A.Y. 2024/25.

The following students **cannot** participate:

- Undergraduate students enrolled in A.Y. 2021/22 who will graduate in the summer session of A.Y. 2024/25 or later;
- Single-cycle degree students (except for medicine and dentistry) enrolled in A.Y. 2019/20 who will graduate in the summer session of A.Y. 2024/25 or later;
- Single-cycle degree students in the medical and dental fields enrolled in A.Y. 2018/19 who will graduate in the summer session of A.Y. 2024/25 or later;
- Master’s degree students enrolled in A.Y. 2022/23 who will graduate in the summer session of A.Y. 2024/25 or later;
- Students enrolled in PhD programs, second-level master’s programs, specialization schools, or research fellowships;
- Incoming students participating in international exchange programs in A.Y. 2024/25 (EXC, SAA, UIC, SEC, etc.).

Application Procedure

Students must complete the application form available at the following [link](#), no later than **April 7, 2025**.

Rankings

Two rankings will be created for each section based on the following criteria

Ranking A – Collegio Seniority Criteria

Sezione CROCETTA:	4 contributions
Sezione SAN PAOLO:	3 contributions
Sezione PO:	3 contributions
Sezione VALENTINO:	3 contributions
Sezione MOLE ANTONELLIANA:	3 contributions

Selection criteria:

- Collegio seniority;
- In case of a tie: academic merit (as in Ranking B);
- In case of a tie: lottery draw.

Ranking B – Academic Merit Criteria

Sezione CROCETTA:	4 contributions
Sezione SAN PAOLO:	4 contributions
Sezione PO:	3 contributions
Sezione VALENTINO:	3 contributions
Sezione MOLE ANTONELLIANA:	3 contributions

Selection criteria:

- Academic merit (based on the study award calculation method, considering achievements between **September 1, 2023, and July 31, 2024**);
- In case of a tie: Collegio seniority (as in Ranking A);
- In case of a tie: lottery draw.

If the student is ranked as a winner in both rankings, the contribution will be assigned based on the ranking where they hold the highest position, thereby freeing up the spot in the ranking where they hold the lower position.

In the event of a tie in both rankings, the contribution will be assigned based on the seniority-based ranking, freeing up the spot in the academic merit-based ranking.

Students who have previously been awarded the same contribution in past editions will be placed at the bottom of the ranking. If a section ranking is exhausted, the contributions will be reassigned to the section with the longest waiting list (within the rankings compiled using the same criteria).

By **April 16, 2025**, the **provisional rankings** will be published on the website and in the Collegio's Intranet area. Candidates may submit any observations via a ticket on the Student Portal.

The **final rankings** will be published by **April 18, 2025**, on the website and in the Collegio's Intranet area, and no further modifications will be possible for any reason.

Acceptance of contribution

Winners must confirm acceptance via **ticket submission** on the Student Portal (subject: "Acceptance of Study Abroad Contribution 2024/25") by **April 28, 2025**. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the rankings.

Payment of contribution

To receive the contribution, winners must:

1. Submit **via ticket on the Student Portal** (subject: "Study Abroad 2024/25 Documentation for Reimbursement") by **September 15, 2025**:
 - a. **Course attendance certificate** issued by the school, indicating the period and number of weekly lessons;
 - b. **Expense documentation** for travel, accommodation, and tuition fees;
 - c. **A written report** (at least one page) including:
 - i. Personal introduction and academic background;
 - ii. Summary of the study abroad experience;
 - iii. Reflection on life at Collegio Einaudi;
 - iv. Future objectives.
2. Provide bank account details in the **IBAN section of the Student Portal**.

The contribution will be paid by the end of November 2025.

Failure to submit the required documents by the deadline or to comply with the specifications of the call will result in the NON-disbursement of the contribution.

Please note that the **Collegio is NOT responsible** for any errors or issues arising from the failure (or incorrect) completion of the IBAN section in the Student Portal or from the failure (or incorrect) updating of personal banking details. Therefore, we strongly encourage all winners to carefully and accurately enter their banking information by the specified deadline.

Loss of Contribution Right

Students who:

- Do not complete the required **minimum training hours** (as per D.M. 673 of 08/09/2016), or
 - Do not complete the **evaluation questionnaire** after finishing their Personalized Training Program,
- will lose their right to the financial contribution.

Withdrawal

Winners who wish to **withdraw** must submit a **ticket on the Student Portal by May 31, 2025**.

Failure to utilize the contribution without formal withdrawal may result in a **penalty equal to the deposit amount**.

For students who leave Collegio permanently, the deposit refund will be processed **after the procedures outlined in this call**.
