

# CALL FOR PROPOSAL

## AWARD GHITA & ARMANDO

full coverage of the student contribution

**A.Y. 2023/24**

### Art. 1 – Description

Collegio Einaudi, thanks to the financial contribution of Dr Margherita Di Leo Monte, is announcing benefits **to cover all or part of the student contribution** for a place at the Collegio for deserving students in financial difficulty.

In particular, students enrolled in the academic year 2023/24 in any course of study (Bachelor's degree, Master's degree or a 5/6-years Master degree), winners under this Call, will be entitled to the following benefit:

1. reimbursement of the first instalment of the student contribution a.y. 2023/24;
2. total exemption of the second and third instalments of the student contribution for the academic year 2023/24, for students belonging to contribution bands 1 to 3;
3. partial exemption of the second and third instalments of the student contribution for the academic year 2023/24, for students belonging to contribution bands higher than bracket 3, up to a maximum of € 3,113 (corresponding to the student contribution - bracket 3);
4. total or partial exemption of all instalments of the student contribution after the academic year 2023/24 up to and including the academic year 2025/26, and until the student obtains a Master degree or a 5/6-years Master degree. (see points 2 and 3 and Art. 3).

Students enrolled in a.y. 2023/24 on III level courses (PhD, 2nd Level Master, Specialization Schools, Advanced Courses) who are successful in this call for applications will be entitled to the following benefits:

1. reimbursement of the first instalment a.y. 2023/24;
2. exemption of the second and third instalments for the academic year 2023/24;
3. exemption of all the instalments of the student contribution after the academic year 2023/24 up to and including the academic year 2025/26, and until the Level III qualification is obtained.

### Art. 2 – Participation Requirements

In order to be admitted to this Call, candidates must meet the following requirements

1. be holders of a study place at Collegio Einaudi in the a.y. 2023/24;
2. be regularly enrolled at a Turin University for the academic year 2023/24;
3. not suspend a study place for the entire academic year 2023/24 for mobility/internship projects;
4. do not hold a study place following agreements stipulated by the Collegio, the tuition for the academic year 2023/24 of which is completely/partially paid by the contracting institution (e.g.: Collegio Carlo Alberto, Scuola di Studi Superiori, INPS ex Enam, etc.).

### Art. 3 – Award Confirmation Requirements

Winners, in order to obtain renewal of the award, must comply with all the following requirements

- a) confirm the study place at Collegio Einaudi for the academic years 2024/25 and 2025/26, in accordance with the provisions of the relevant Confirmation Call;
- b) not incur disciplinary sanctions pursuant to Article XXIII.1, letters d) and e) of the current Regulations for study place holders.

In the case of mobility periods abroad:

- for periods of less than the entire academic year, the Award shall be prorated on the basis of the instalments of the annual student contribution referring to the period of stay at the Collegio;
- for periods equal to the entire academic year, the Award will be 'frozen' and reconfirmed for the following year, if the merit requirements as per art. 2.a are maintained.

Participants in this competition are invited to assess the compatibility of awards with other grants from public and private entities. In this regard, please note that the winning of an award under this Call is not compatible with other grants awarded by the Collegio in the current academic year, with the exception of international mobility grants. Winning students will be asked to sign an appropriate declaration with their online application.

Participation in this call for applications implies acceptance of every article contained herein.

### Art. 4 – Total amount of awards

The total amount of the awards announced for the academic year 2023/24 is approximately € 10,000, granted to cover all or part (see art.1) of the contribution to be paid by the winning students for the study place at the Collegio, up to a maximum amount of € 3113 (corresponding to the contribution to be paid by the student - 3rd bracket).

The economic relationship established does not constitute a claim of any kind against the Collegio Einaudi.

The amount of the awards is subject to the withholding taxes provided for by law.

### Art. 5 – Modalities of participation and application period

The application for participation must be submitted by filling in the appropriate online form available at the following link <https://forms.gle/wJ9iDsFoQUx2dkmB8> **between 20 September and 15 October 2023.**

By the same deadline, candidates must send by ticket on the Student Portal (subject: "Participation in the Ghita&Armando 2023 Call")

- Candidate family, highlighting the economic difficulties encountered in this period also due to the effects of the post-pandemic crisis;
  - Candidate academic background;
  - Candidate personal interests;
  - future plans in the educational and personal sphere.
- 2) Self-certification of exams taken throughout the academic career<sup>1</sup>.

#### **Art. 6 – Award Procedure and Evaluation Committee**

The applications will be analysed by an Evaluation Committee consisting of:

- Dr Margherita Di Leo Monte;
- at least 1 representative of Collegio Einaudi;
- at least 1 former student identified by the President of the Foundation.

On the basis of the number of applications received, the Commission may decide to conduct a cognitive interview with the candidates.

In awarding the awards, priority will be given to candidates enrolled in Level I and II degree courses.

After analysing and evaluating the applications, the Commission will assign one or more awards up to an indicative threshold of € 10,000 (see art. 4) at its sole discretion.
