The study prizes will be awarded on the basis of merit rankings and will have different amounts, as follows:



It should be noted that the funds, bound by donors, are reserved for the following **Degree Courses:**

- Aerospace or Energy Engineering
- Chemical or Chemical Engineering
- Management Engineering and / or Economics
- Mechanical engineering
- ICT area
- Medicine
- MFN Sciences
- Humanistic area

Any additional funds, not tied to specific study paths, will be assigned:

- Between the **PoliTO**, **UniTO Umanistici**, **UniTO Scientifici groupings** in a proportion equal to the distribution of the Collegio population among the same groups;
- •
- As a percentage of types of amount such as to favor the **SILVER** and, above all, **BRONZE** denomination.

Requirements for the assignment of a Study Award:

Having been holder of a study place in the academic year 2022/23 for at least 5 months;

In the case of students involved in international mobility study projects, having used the hospitality service of the Collegio for at least 5 months during the academic year 2022/23;

Apply in the **period between 7/11/2023 and 22/11/2023.**



They will not be able to participate in this Call:

- students of 1st level courses who enrolled in a.y. prior to 2020/21;
- students of single-cycle degree courses (except Medicine and Dentistry) who enrolled in a.y. prior to 2018/19;
- students of single-cycle degree courses in the health area (Medicine and Dentistry) who enrolled in a.y. prior to 2017/18;
- students of master's degree courses enrolled in a.y. prior to 2021/22;
- the students holding a study place following agreements stipulated by the Collegio, whose tuition for the academic year 2022/23 is fully paid by the affiliated institution (eg: Collegio Carlo Alberto, Scuola di Studi Superiori di Torino, INPS ex Enam, etc.);
- students with study positions enrolled in research doctorates, 2nd level masters, specialization schools, advanced courses.

• Participants in this Call are invited to **evaluate the compatibility of the Study Prizes up for grabs with other provisions of public and private bodies.** In this regard, it should be noted that EDISU Piemonte has confirmed the compatibility of this announcement with its scholarship.

Methods for submitting the application and formulating the rankings

For each group, the ranking of all the applications presented will be formulated on the basis of the score obtained by each candidate, calculated as follows:

Academic performance: with the attribution of a score deriving from the weighted average of the marks on the credits acquired in the academic year 2022/23 (exams taken from 1 September 2022 to 31 July 2023), multiplied by a corrective factor, equal to the lower of "1 "And the ratio between the number of credits acquired in the academic year of reference and the value set by Collegio as follows:

- 52 credits for students enrolled in bachelor's (three-year) or single-cycle degree courses in the academic year 2022/23;
- **56 credits** for students enrolled, in the academic year 2022/23, for **years subsequent to the first one** in bachelor's or single-cycle degree courses and for students enrolled in courses of master's degree.





Credits acquired in **exams that do not involve grades**, and for which only passing is recognized (including the thesis), will not contribute to the calculation of the weighted average of the marks, but will be considered in the calculation of the corrective factor.

Any **extra exams** (for example those taken as part of the Enterprising project of the Politecnico) will not contribute to forming either the weighted average or the corrective factor.

Honors will not be evaluated for the purpose of calculating the weighted average. The weighted average, correction factor and score values will be rounded to the third decimal number¹.

In the event of a **tie resulting** from the two criteria described above, the ranking will be drawn up according to the following criteria, to be applied in succession in the event of a tie:

- greater number of honors;
- indicator of the equivalent economic situation of the lowest household.

The study prizes will not be awarded to students who will result in the ranking with a score lower than 20.

If a student has already won a prize from the Call for Study Awards for the academic year 2021/22, it will be placed at the end of the reference ranking.

To submit an application under this Call, it is necessary to:

- 1. fill in the participation form at the link https://forms.gle/LHkkqEa6KVi9Lxsy8 in the period from **7 November to 22 November 2023**;
- 2. aupdate, if necessary, the self-certification of the exams taken as at 31/7/2023 in the OTHER DOCUMENTS area of the Student Portal.

After the publication of the provisional rankings, for the assignment of prizes specifically titled, the temporary winners may be involved in moments of in-depth study and knowledge of their history through an interview and/or production of a written paper, following of which the final rankings will be published.

If it is not possible to use all the Study Awards announced due to a lack of candidates, any funds used for the institutional activities of the Foundation for the year 2023.

¹Rounding will be done by approximating the third decimal place downwards, if the fourth decimal place is between 0 and 4, upwards, if the fourth decimal place is between 5 and 9.



Further study awards may also be awarded that may be made available for this Call by and no later than the day of publication of the final rankings.

The student who has been assigned a free study place will not be able to obtain the assignment of a study award granted by the Collegio for the same academic year.

The provisional rankings will be published in the Collegio's intranet area **by 4 December 2023**. **These rankings will become definitive on 7 December 2023**.

The winners of the Study Prizes covered by this Call will be asked to upload in the OTHER DOCUMENTS area of the Student Portal of:

- presentation form of their academic career;
- a half-length photograph and one in the context of study/internship;
- the authorization to use the material requested for the institutional purposes of Collegio;
- fill in the IBAN area of the Student Portal, carefully checking the bank details provided.
