Recipients

The recipients of the award are the students of the Collegio who:

- 1. have been holders of a study place in Collegio for the academic year 2022/2023;
- 2. have obtained, or are about to obtain, the single-cycle master's / master's degree in the period from 1 September 2022 to 31 December 2023;
- 3. have been enrolled in one of the following single-cycle or master's degree courses:
 - Medicine and Surgery
 - Chemistry and Pharmaceutical Technologies
 - Pharmacy
 - · Biomedical Engineering
 - Dentistry
 - Biotechnology

How to participate

Candidates must by and no later than 15th February 2024:

- fill in the online form available at the link https://forms.gle/oEU1PJdGjYV1Sm9m6;
- upload on the "OTHER DOCUMENTS" Area of the Student Portal
 - self-certification / master's degree certificate with exams²;
 - **abstract of the thesis**, of maximum 4 pages, in which the candidate explains the objectives and main results of the work carried out, as well as the methods of carrying out, with particular regard to the attendance of laboratories, centers, departments; if the abstract is presented in English, a summary in Italian must be included within the 4 pages;

¹ Students who, during the academic year 2022/23 have been involved in international / national mobility projects (e.g. Erasmus mobility projects) and have maintained the ownership of the place of study in Collegio for at least 5 months in the academic year 2022/23.

- **letter of introduction of the candidate** from the thesis supervisor or from the professor of the foreign university, or from the company tutor.

Only applications for which candidates have submitted all the required documentation in the manner mentioned above will be considered valid.

How to select the winners

The winners of the prizes will be identified by a Scientific Commission designated by the Board of Directors of Collegio. The Commission will be able to make use of the scientific collaboration of teachers from the departments concerned.

The Commission will assess:

- a) the costs, methods of carrying out and objectives of the thesis, with particular regard to the international significance of the thesis work carried out, as well as the attendance of laboratories, departments and centers for the preparation of the thesis project;
- b) the university curriculum of the candidate.

The choice of the winners will be made - in the first instance - among the graduates of the degree course in Medicine and Surgery and, if the Commission does not identify suitable candidates for this course assignment of the degree prize, among the graduates of the other degree courses listed above.

The Commission's judgment will be final.

Final rankings will be published on the College's INTRANET by March 15, 2024. Notification of the publication will be given via the College's website and via social media.

Methods of disbursement of awards

The award will be paid out in a **single payment**, by the end of **April 2024**, by bank transfer to a current account in the name or joint name of the winner.

Any additional costs relating to payment operations (eg: foreign bank transfer) will be borne by the winner.

Following the publication of the rankings, the winners must communicate their bank details by filling in or updating the IBAN area of the Student Portal.
