
# **5** Residence Halls

## **How much does Collegio Einaudi cost?**







The Collegio's annual fee is **7.800 €**,

but our students pay only a portion, ranging from €2,464 to €6,281 annually and divided into 3 installments.





The fee charged to students is calculated based on their household's **ISEE statement for college benefits** (issued starting January 2024) and includes all Collegio's services.





