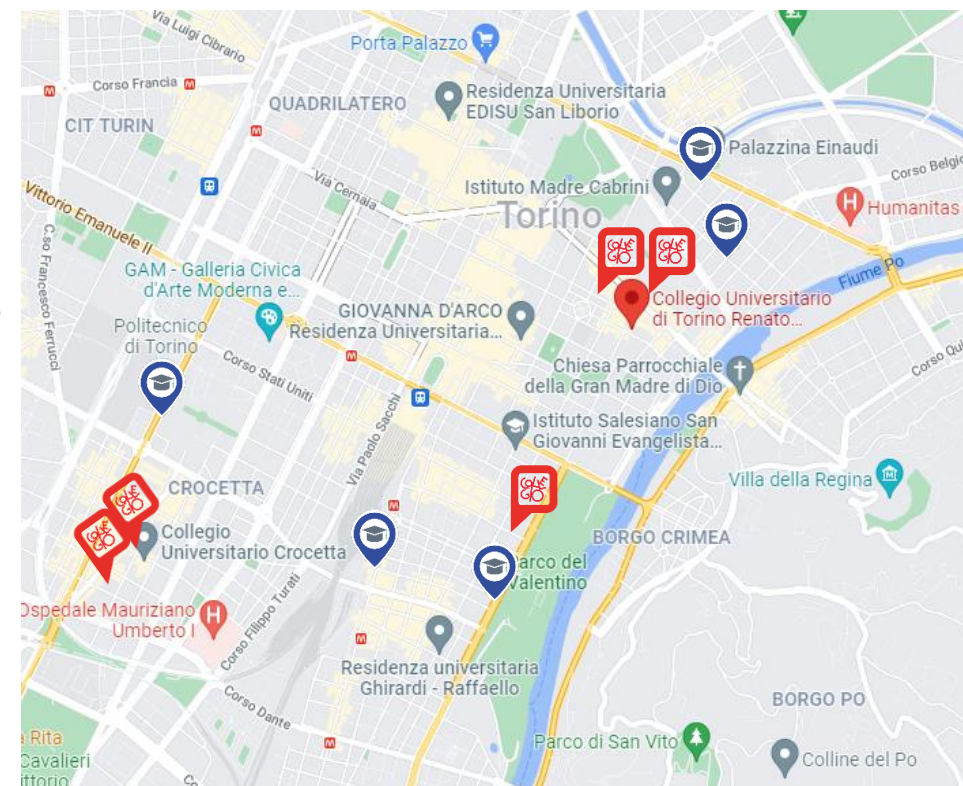
## 5 Residence Halls

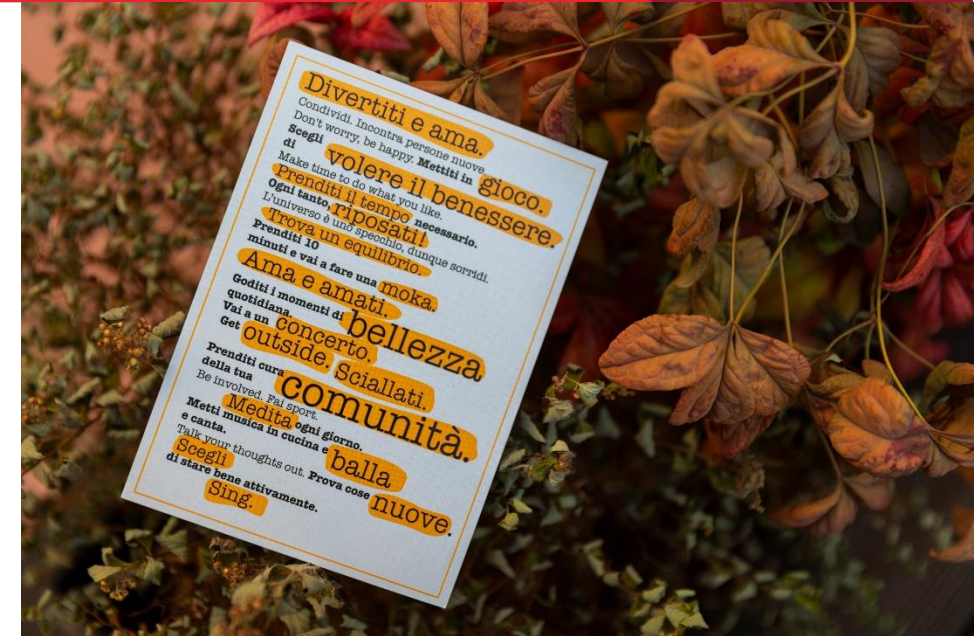

Every student at Collegio Einaudi personalizes their own learning course, by defining an annual '**Piano Formativo Personalizzato**' (PFP), which lasts:



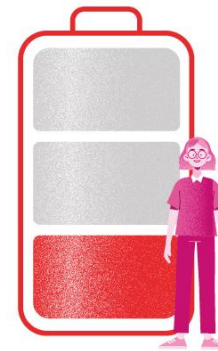
**70 hours**

# How much does Collegio Einaudi cost?



The Collegio's annual fee is **7.800 €**,

but **our students pay only a portion**, ranging from **€2,464** to **€6,281** annually  
and divided into **3 installments**.

The fee charged to students is calculated based on their household's **ISEE statement for college benefits** (issued starting January 2024) and includes all Collegio's services.
