Art. 1 – Description

Collegio Einaudi announces **No. 5**

**benefits to fully cover the tuition for a study place at the Collegio,
in favor of meritorious female students in financial difficulty**

(as per the precise testamentary will of former student Dr. Anna Bonino), who will be regularly enrolled in the a.y. 2024/25 in any course of study (bachelor's degree, master's degree, single-cycle master's degree).

Specifically, the benefit consists of the **total exemption** of the student's contribution on tuition for one to three years, possibly renewable until the conclusion of the course of study.

Art. 2 – Requirements

Participating female students, for the purpose of this call, will be identified according to the following categories:

RUNNER¹, STARTER DIPLOMATE², STARTER ISCRITTE³

In order to be eligible for this call, applicants must meet the following participation requirements:

¹ «**Runner**» means female students already holding a study place at Collegio Einaudi in a.y. 2023/24, who participate in the Call for Confirmation for a.y. 2024/25;

² Starter «**diplomate**» refers to female students obtaining by 30/07/2024 the High School Diploma, who do not yet hold a study place at Collegio Einaudi, but who have completed the admission process (Admission Call BAM) for the year 2024/25;

³ Starter «**iscritte**» means female students already enrolled in any undergraduate degree program, master's degree program, single-cycle master's degree program, not yet holding a study place at Collegio Einaudi, but who have completed the admission process (Admission Call BAM) for the year 2024/25.

Art. 3 – Evaluating committee and awarding methods

Applications will be analyzed by an evaluation committee appointed by the Board of Directors.

Based on the number of applications received, the Commission may decide whether to conduct a cognitive interview with the candidates.

For the «starter» candidates, the first 50 applications received will be considered, and only female students who have won the first and second assignment of the study place in the Collegio will be eligible (these will be announced by August 6 and 12, 2024, respectively).

Three separate rankings will be made (one for graduate starters, one for registered starters, and one for runners), considering the following merit requirements:

- **Starter «diplomate» ranking:** the overall score expressed in hundredths and obtained from the sum of the evaluation of the school merit requirement (up to a maximum of 60/100) and the potential (up to a maximum of 40/100) obtained during the admission process for the BAM (Call for Admission) 2024/25 will be taken into consideration. In addition, graduating female starter students will necessarily **have to report their high school diploma grade by 30/07/2024**, which - in case of a tie - will take over as an additional benchmark. Approximately **2 free study places** will be awarded.
- **Starter «iscritte» ranking:** the overall score expressed in hundredths and obtained from the sum of the evaluation of the academic merit requirement (up to a maximum of 60/100) and potential (up to a maximum of 40/100) obtained during the admission process for the BAM ("Call for Admission") 2024/25 will be taken into account. In case of a tie, the **highest number of honors** will be taken into consideration. Approximately **1 free study place** will be awarded.
- **«Runner» ranking⁴:** will be formulated on the basis of the score obtained by each candidate, calculated as follows: attribution of a score resulting from the weighted average of grades on credits acquired in the academic year 2023/24 (exams passed between October 1, 2023 and July 15, 2024), multiplied by a corrective factor, equal to the lesser of "1" and the ratio between the No. of credits acquired in the academic year of reference and the value set by the College of 32 credits. In case of a tie, the **highest number of honors** will be taken into account. Approximately **2 free study places** will be awarded.

⁴ All exams on the certificate produced by the University will be taken into account. Language proficiency exams and any other exams without a numerical grade will count toward the number of credits earned, scoring 25/30.

After examining and evaluating the applications and drawing up the rankings, **the Commission will award the benefits at its sole discretion**, reserving the right not to award them if there are not enough and/or suitable applications, or to distribute them differently among the three categories of participants if the type and number of applications make it necessary. The Commission also reserves the right to provide additional cash benefits if the socio-economic situation of the applicant(s) is particularly disadvantaged.



The results – showing only the USER ID (e.g., 100003) of each applicant, along with the award/eligibility for the benefit - will be published on **August 6, 2024** on the Collegio Einaudi website, on the page dedicated to the call for applications.

Art. 4 – Benefit confirmation requirements and safeguard clause

The winners, in order to obtain the renewal of the benefit, must meet all the following requirements:

- a) confirm the study place** at Collegio Einaudi for the academic years 2025/26 and 2026/27, in accordance with the relevant Confirmation Notices;
- b) not be subject to disciplinary action** as per the provisions of the 'Disciplinary Proceedings' section of the Regulations for Study Place Holders for the relevant academic year.

If the requirements in paragraphs (a) and (b) above are not met, female students who are already beneficiaries will be required to repay the amount of the student contribution provided for their income bracket, including any additional cash contributions awarded under this call.

In the case of year-long periods of mobility abroad, the benefit will be 'frozen' and reconfirmed for the following year, if the merit requirements set out in the relevant Call for Confirmation are met.

Art. 5 – Compatibility with other benefits

Participants in this call for applications are invited to **consider the compatibility of the awards offered with other benefits from public and private entities**. In this regard, please note that the awarding of a benefit under this call is not compatible with other benefits provided by the Collegio in the current academic year, except for international mobility grants. Winning students will be required to sign an appropriate declaration when applying online.

Compatibility with "**Bando EDISU Piemonte per il conferimento di borse di studio, servizio abitativo e premio di laurea**": we point out that the benefit awarded under this call is only compatible with the "IN SEDE" student category for the scholarship amount purposes. It is also incompatible with housing service and "Einaudi option".

The list of winners of this call will be reported to EDISU PIEMONTE.

Participation in this call implies acceptance of each article contained herein.

Art. 6 – Terms of participation and application period



Applications must be submitted by filling out the appropriate online form available at the following link [here](#) during the period between **June 21 and July 15, 2024**.

By the same deadline, applicants should submit via ticket on the Student Portal (subject line: "Bonino 2024 Call"):

1. Motivational letter, with information related to:

A short introduction of the candidate representing

- his/her academic/scholastic background;
- one's personal interests;
- future plans in the educational and personal spheres;
- the socio-economic situation of the household.

2. A contact, for possible references, of a specific reference person, substantiating the candidate's motivation and aspirations.

3. Self-certification updated as of the date of application of exams taken (for the category of «runner»⁵ students only) showing all exams taken and validated as of 15/07/2024.

4. Self-certification/Certificate issued by the high school showing the grade achieved in the State Examination (for the «starter diplomate» category only).
