## Description

The Foundation Collegio Universitario Renato Einaudi di Torino announces,  
as regards the academic year 2024/2025,

### **n.3 career awards of € 1,000 gross each**

in memory of Engineer Ermanno Borio, established thanks to the generous testamentary bequest of Ms. Clara Borio, sister of Ermanno, an alumnus of the Collegio from 1949 to 1954.

The awards are divided as follows:

#### **N. 2 AWARDS RESERVED FOR GRADUATES OF FIRST-LEVEL DEGREE COURSES BELONGING TO THE FOLLOWING GRADUATE CLASSES (Group former I faculty):**

- Aerospace Engineering;
- Biomedical engineering;
- Chemical and food engineering;
- Civil engineering;
- Construction engineering;
- Electrical engineering;
- Power engineering;
- Mechanical engineering;
- Environmental and land use engineering;
- Engineering mathematics;
- Spatial, urban and landscape/environmental planning;
- Materials engineering;
- Industrial production engineering.

#### **N. 1 AWARD RESERVED FOR GRADUATES OF FIRST-LEVEL DEGREE COURSES BELONGING TO THE FOLLOWING GRADUATE CLASSES (Group former III and IV faculty):**

- Automotive Engineering;
- Telecommunications engineering;
- Electrical engineering;
- Management engineering;
- Computer Engineering;
- Film and media engineering;
- Physical engineering;
- Technologies for the manufacturing industry.

## Recipients

Recipients of the award are male and female students of the Collegio who:

- have been holders of a place of study at the Collegio in the academic year 2024/2025<sup>1</sup>;
- have been **enrolled in the a.a. 2024/25 at Turin Politecnico University** in a bachelor's degree course among those indicated in the above groups;
- have **enrolled in a bachelor's degree program in the a.y. 2022/23**;
- have obtained, or are in the process of obtaining, a bachelor's degree by December 31, 2025 with a **graduation grade of 100/110 or higher**;
- have **obtained confirmation of the study place at Collegio for the academic year 2025/26**.

The following **shall not be eligible** to participate in this call for applications:

- students **holding a study place as a result of agreements with the Collegio**, whose tuition for A.Y. 2024/25 has been completely/partially paid by the contracted institution (e.g.: Collegio Carlo Alberto, SSST, INPS ex Enam, etc.);
- student(s) **who won a free study place or Ghita&Armando award or a GOLD study award** for a.y. 2024/25.

**Compatibility with 'EDISU Piedmont call for applications for scholarships, scholarship service and degree award': please note that the benefit awarded under this call is compatible with the benefits provided by Edisu Piemonte.**

## Modalities of participation

Applicants must **no later than December 31, 2025**:

1. fill out the online form available at the [following link](#);
2. send via ticket on the Student Portal (subject: “Borio Career Awards 2025”):
  - self-certification of all the exams taken in the entire Bachelor's degree course, showing the academic year of enrollment, weighted average, total number of cfu, the achievement of the Bachelor's degree and the grade obtained<sup>2</sup>;
  - motivation letter written by the candidate;
  - letters of reference, if any, from the thesis supervisor/ thesis advisor and/or the faculty member from the foreign university and/or the company mentor.

Only applications for which applicants have submitted all the required documentation in the manner mentioned above will be considered valid.

<sup>1</sup> Students who have been engaged in international/domestic mobility projects (e.g., Erasmus mobility projects) during A.Y. 2024/25 and have maintained their place in the Collegio for at least 5 months in the same academic year are also eligible to apply to the call.

## Method of constructing the rankings

A ranking will be made for each grouping based on the sum of the scores listed below:

- up to a maximum of 110 points corresponding to the grade of bachelor's degree<sup>3</sup>;
- up to a maximum of 30 points corresponding to the weighted average of the exams taken in the entire bachelor's degree course;
- up to a maximum of 15 points awarded by a Scientific Committee appointed by the Collegio Board, which will evaluate:
  - a. the time taken to finish studies;
  - b. the evaluation of the course of study done partially or fully in English;
  - c. A set of information about the student's graduation record (e.g., number of honors earned, foreign course, any extracurricular activities, etc.).
- up to a maximum of 5 points awarded by Collegio's Staff to those having confirmed their study place in Collegio for a.y. 2025/26 thus reaffirming their loyalty to the Einaudi community project.

The Commission's assessments will also take into account the diversity of the degree courses and the gender equality of the candidates. **The judgment of the committee will be final.**

**The final rankings will be published on the Collegio's website by February 27, 2026. Notification of the publication will be given via social channels and the Collegio's website.**

## Arrangements for disbursement of awards

**Prizes will be disbursed in one lump sum, by the end of March 2026, by bank transfer to a bank account in the name or joint name of the winner(s).**

Any incidental expenses related to payment transactions (e.g., foreign transfer) will be borne by the winner/winner. **Following the publication of the rankings, winners will have to communicate their bank details by filling in or updating the IBAN area of the Student Portal.**
