
## **5** Residence Halls

Learning at Collegio Einaudi is a transformative experience that, together with community life, contributes to personal growth and prepares students to face future challenges.


The training and services offered are highly personalized to enrich the university experience and prepare students to become active and positive contributors to society.






# **Experiences you will live with Collegio's training!**





### **How much does Collegio Einaudi cost?**





The Collegio's annual fee is **7.800 €**,

but our students pay only a part, ranging from € 2.464 to € 6.281 annually and divided into 3 installments.

The fee charged to students is calculated based on their household's **ISEE statement for college benefits** (issued starting January 2025) and includes all Collegio's services.


