Art. 1 - Description

Collegio Einaudi announces 2 benefits covering the full cost of the study place at the Collegio:

- n. 1 benefit exclusively for **deserving female students** in financial difficulty (as per the express testamentary will of former Collegio student Dr. Anna Bonino), who will be regularly enrolled in the 2025/26 academic year in the **first year** of a bachelor's degree program or a single-cycle master's degree program;
- n. 1 benefit for **deserving students (male or female)** in financial difficulty, who will be regularly enrolled in the 2025/26 academic year in the **first year** of a bachelor's or a single-cycle master's degree program, named after Ghita and Armando Monte.

The benefit consists of **full exemption** from the student's contribution towards the accommodation fee, under the following terms:

- ANNA BONINO: from one to three years, renewable until completion of the degree program
- GHITA & ARMANDO MONTE: for one year, potentially renewable for a second year.

Art. 2 – Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this Call, applicants must meet the following requirements:

Art. 3 – Evaluation Committee and Awarding Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by an Evaluation Committee composed as follows:

- one representative from the Bonino family;
- one appointee from the Monte family;
- one representative from Collegio Einaudi, appointed by the Board of Directors of the Collegio Universitario Einaudi Foundation;

Based on the number of applications received, the Committee may decide to conduct interviews with the candidates.

Only the first **50 applications** received for each benefit will be considered.

Grants can only be awarded to students who have won a study place at the Collegio in the first or second assignment round (which will be communicated by **August 7** and **August 12**, **2025**, respectively).

Two separate rankings will be drawn up, one for each benefit, based on the following merit criteria:

• The overall score expressed in hundredths and obtained from the sum of the evaluation of the school merit requirement (up to a maximum of **60/100**) and the potential (up to a maximum of **40/100**) obtained during the 2025/26 BAM (Admission Call) will be taken into consideration. Additionally, students must provide their **final high school exam grade by July 30, 2025**, which will be used as a tie-breaker if candidates have the same overall score.

Once the applications are reviewed and rankings compiled, the Committee **will award the benefits at its sole discretion**, reserving the right not to award them if there are insufficient and/or unsuitable applications. The Committee also reserves the right to provide additional financial support in cases of particularly disadvantaged socio-economic conditions. Additional Free Study Places may be awarded if new funds become available before **October 31, 2025**.



The results – showing only the USER ID (e.g., 100003) of each candidate, together with the assignment or eligibility status – will be published on **August 7, 2025** on the Collegio Einaudi website, on the page dedicated to this Call.

Art. 4 – Renewal Requirements and Safeguard Clause

To renew the benefit, winners must:

- a) Confirm their study place at Collegio Einaudi for the academic years 2026/27 and 2027/28, in accordance with the relevant Confirmation Calls;
- **b) Not be subject to disciplinary measures** as outlined in the "Disciplinary Procedures" section of the Regulations for holders of study places for the relevant academic year.

If the above conditions a) and b) are not met, students who were previously granted the benefit will be required to reimburse the student contribution fee corresponding to their income bracket, including any additional financial benefits granted under this Call.

In the case of a full-year study abroad program, the benefit will be "frozen" and reinstated the following year, provided the merit requirements of the relevant Confirmation Call are still met.



Art. 5 – Compatibility with Other Scholarships and Grants

Applicants are encouraged to assess the **compatibility** of the benefits offered in this Call with those awarded by other public or private entities.

Please note that the benefits awarded under this Call are **not compatible** with other grants from Collegio Einaudi in the same academic year, **except** for international mobility scholarships.

Winners will be asked to submit a **specific declaration** when applying online.

Compatibility with "Bando EDISU Piemonte per il conferimento di borse di studio, servizio abitativo e premio di laurea": we point out that the benefit awarded under this call is only compatible with the "IN SEDE" student category for the scholarship amount purposes. It is also incompatible with housing service and "Einaudi option".

The list of winners of this Call will be shared with EDISU Piemonte.

Art. 6 – How to Apply and Application Period



Applications must be submitted by filling out the online form available <u>here</u> **between June 20 and July 15, 2025**.

By the same deadline, applicants must send the following documents via ticket on the Student Portal (subject: "Application for Free Study Place Call"):

1. A motivation letter, including:

A brief self-introduction outlining:

- academic/educational background
- personal interests
- · future educational and personal goals
- socio-economic situation of the family unit.
- 2. At least one **reference contact** (a person who can confirm the applicant's motivation and aspirations)
- 3. A self-certification or official certificate from the high school showing the final grade obtained in the State Exam.
