Call for free study places "Giovanni Lino Bianco"

Art. 1 – Description

Collegio Einaudi, thanks to the testamentary bequest of former student Eng. Giovanni Lino Bianco, consisting of a package of ENI SpA shares

announces 1 benefit covering the full tuition fee for accommodation in the Collegio, called the "Scholarship in memory of Giovanni Lino Bianco", in favor of students who, by explicit testamentary will, are enrolled in the Department of Management and Production Engineering at Politecnico di Torino.

The benefit consists of the total exemption of the student's contribution to accommodation fees for the entire duration of the study program, up to the achievement of the master's degree (with the possibility of considering continuation in a post-graduate program), provided that the study place in the Collegio is confirmed year by year.

Art. 2 – Eligibility Requirements

Applicants will be identified under the following categories:

RUNNER¹, STARTER DIPLOMATI/E², STARTER ISCRITTI/E³

To be admitted to this call, candidates must meet the following requirements:

¹ For "runner" are intended those students who already hold a study place at Collegio Einaudi in the a.y. 2024/25, and who have obtained confirmation of their study place for the a.y. 2025/26.

Art. 3 – Selection Committee and Awarding Procedure

Applications will be evaluated by a Selection Committee appointed by the Board of Directors.

Depending on the number of applications received, the Committee may decide to conduct an interview with the candidates. For all categories, only the first 50 applications received will be considered.

Three separate rankings will be drawn up (one for each category), based on the following merit criteria:

- **Starter “diplomati/e” ranking:** Score out of 100, consisting of academic merit (up to 60/100) and potential (up to 40/100) assessed during the admission process for the BAM (Admission Call) 2025/26.

In case of equal scores, **the high school diploma grade will be the tiebreaker.**

- **Starter “iscritti/e” ranking:** Score out of 100, consisting of academic merit (up to 60/100) and potential (up to 40/100) assessed during the BAM admission process 2025/26.

In case of equal scores, **the highest number of honors will be considered.**

- **“Runner” ranking⁴:** score calculated from the weighted average of exam grades obtained in the a.y. 2024/25 (exams taken between October 1, 2024, and July 31, 2025), multiplied by a correction factor equal to the lesser of “1” and the ratio between the number of credits earned in that year and the Collegio threshold of 52 credits.

In case of equal scores, **the highest number of honors will be considered.**

After evaluating applications and drafting rankings, **the Committee will assign the benefits at its sole discretion**, reserving the right not to award them if there are insufficient and/or unsuitable applications.



The results – showing only the **USER ID (e.g., 100003) of each candidate**, together with the benefit assignment/eligibility – will be published by **October 22, 2025** on the Collegio Einaudi website, in the dedicated page.

² For starter “diplomati/e”, are intended those students who have obtained their high school diploma, completed the admission process (BAM) for the a.y. 2025/26, and who hold a study place at the Collegio by 05/10/2025.

³ For starter “Iscritti/e”, are intended those students already enrolled in any bachelor’s degree program, master’s degree, or single-cycle master’s degree, who have completed the admission process (BAM) for the a.y. 2025/26, and who hold a study place at the Collegio by 05/10/2025.

⁴ All exams listed on the certificate issued by the University will be taken into consideration. Language proficiency exams and any other exams without a numerical grade will count towards the total number of credits earned, with a grade of 25/30 assigned to them.

Art. 4 – Methods of disbursement and renewal of the benefit – and related safeguard clauses

The benefit will consist of:

- full refund of the first installment already paid (if applicable) for a.y. 2025/26; esenzione dal pagamento delle rate successive per l'a.a. 2025/26;
- exemption from payment of the remaining installments for a.y. 2025/26;
- exemption from payment of the student's contribution to accommodation fees for the entire duration of the study program, up to the achievement of the master's degree (with the possibility of considering continuation in a post-graduate program).

In order to obtain renewal of the benefit:

- the number of ENI SpA shares that may need to be sold to cover the full tuition fee must ensure that the total number of remaining shares does not fall below the amount of the original package;
- furthermore, the winner must meet all of the following requirements:
 - a. confirmation of the study place at Collegio Einaudi for subsequent years, as required by the related Confirmation Calls;
 - b. not incurring any disciplinary sanctions under Art. XXIII.1 of the Regulations for study place holders in the relevant academic year.

If the second requirement above is not met, the beneficiary student will be required to return the contribution amount applicable to their income bracket for that academic year.

In case of study abroad periods lasting one year, the benefit will be “frozen” and confirmed for the following year, provided that the merit requirements of the Renewal Call are met.

Art. 5 – Compatibility with other benefits

Applicants should carefully check compatibility of this award with other grants from public or private entities. The benefit from this call is **not compatible with other benefits granted** by Collegio in the current academic year, except for international mobility scholarships. Winners will be required to sign a specific declaration when submitting the online application.

**Compatibility with “EDISU Piemonte Call for scholarships, housing service, and graduation award”:
the benefit is only compatible with the “IN SEDE” student category for scholarship amount purposes.
It is incompatible with housing services and the so-called “Einaudi option.”
The list of winners of this call will be communicated to EDISU Piemonte.**

Art. 6 – Application Procedure and Deadline



Applications must be submitted by filling in the online form available at the [following link](#) between **September 23 and October 5, 2025**.

By the same deadline, candidates must submit through the Student Portal (ticket subject: *Participation in Call for Free Study Place “Giovanni Lino Bianco”*) the following documents:

- 1. Motivation letter**, including:
 - a brief self-presentation covering:
 - academic/school background;
 - personal interests;
 - future educational and personal projects;
 - family socio-economic situation.
- 2. at least one reference contact** who can confirm the candidate’s motivation and aspirations.
- 3. Self-declaration⁵** updated to the application date listing all exams taken and validated by 31/07/2025 (for “starter iscritti/e” and “runner” categories).
- 4. Self-declaration/Certificate** from the high school reporting the final grade of the State Exam (for “starter diplomati/e” category only).

About Giovanni Lino Bianco

Giovanni Lino Bianco was a student at Collegio Einaudi from 1952 to 1957. Originally from Asti and coming from a very modest background, he managed to graduate thanks to the opportunities offered by the Collegio and the support of the friendships built during his university years. After graduating in Engineering and completing a Postgraduate Diploma in Industrial Organization, he pursued a brilliant career in business consulting.

The Collegio was not just a chapter of his life. Together with other former students, Lino founded the GACUP – Gruppo Amici Collegio Universitario e Politecnico which, for 70 years, has met at least once a year to renew the friendships born in the Collegio.

This deep bond with the institution, which had given him the foundation for his future, led him many years later to make a generous and forward-looking gesture: including the Collegio in his will. Lino left an important bequest to the Collegio, which speaks not only of gratitude, but also of trust in the future and of a desire to support new generations of students in a field of study he considered of great value.
